- ◆ Comply with the Awards Requirements section of Hike Aid 6, "High Adventure Awards Program", with specific attention to satisfying the General Requirements listed on page 3.
- ◆ Satisfy, as a Unit or individually, each of the Specific Requirements for the award, as shown on subsequent pages of Hike Aid 6.
- ◆ Obtain awards earned by participants by completing the following Application, getting any required LAAC-HAT approval, and taking it to the Scout Shop in the LAAC Service Center.

The LAAC-HAT does not approve a Unit's outdoor program or specific outings or activities. That is the responsibility of the Unit Committee.

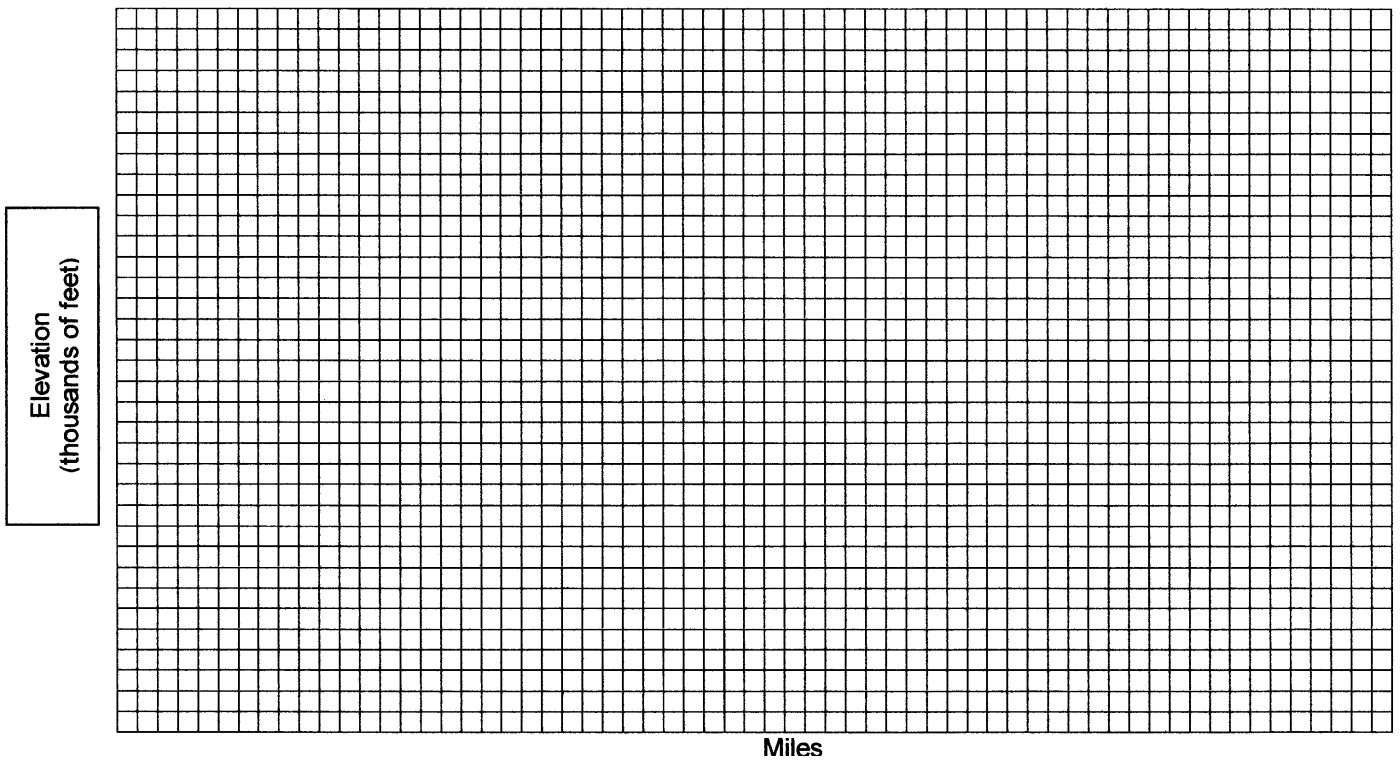
